new guide
issued on the occasion of the 1150th anniversary
of the arrival of the missionaries to the Slavs
Saints Cyril and Methodius
to the territory of Great Moravia.

The publication titled DUCHOVNÍ DĚDICTVÍ MORAVY A SLEZSKA (Spiritual legacy of Moravia and Silesia) includes more than 100 most important sacral monuments, places of pilgrimage and pilgrims' paths. Czech-Polish and German-Italian language mutations introduce spiritual world, rich in traditions and denominations, of the four regions of Moravia to nationals of at least seven Central European countries. Altogether, more than 210 millions of people speak the above mentioned languages, which constitutes two fifths of all inhabitants of the European Union and one fourth of Europeans on the whole.

The guide offers a chance of visiting selected destinations individually or within 14 suggested trips, which are accompanied by a map showing paths for pedestrians, bikers and motorists. Apart from spiritually significant places the catalogue recommends, as a bonus, also a number of attractive places close in location and useful contacts.

SPIRITUAL LEGACY OF MORAVIA AND SILESIA will be a welcome and favorite guide both for visitors from the Czech Republic and for guests from abroad! The new catalogue with sacral themes is another proof of the great tourist potential of the four regions of Moravia.
